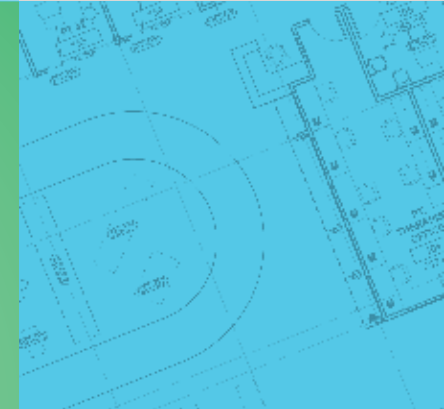

## Farewell Dr. Sutton

Dr. Reid Sutton said his final goodbyes at Horizon Health December 31, ending an illustrious 42-year career of serving the Edgar County community.

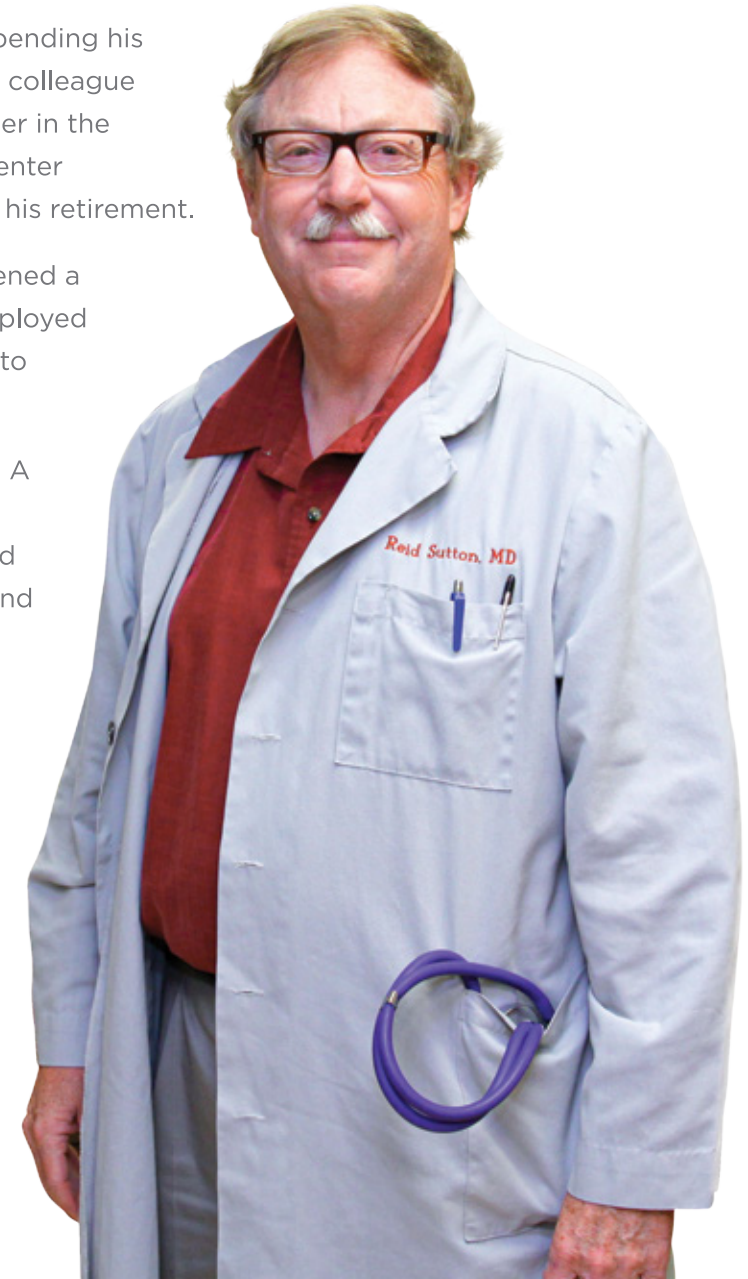
He was a highly respected internal medicine physician, spending his last few years as a hospitalist before retiring. Like his late colleague and dear friend Dr. Leland Phipps, Dr. Sutton was a pioneer in the evolution of Paris Community Hospital/Family Medical Center (PCH/FMC), which became Horizon Health a year before his retirement.

Dr. Sutton spent his entire medical career in Paris. He opened a private practice in July 1977 and became a PCH/FMC employed physician in September 2004. He was recruited to come to Paris by former surgeon Dr. Jerry Ingalls.

Dr. Sutton retired from his clinic practice August 31, 2015. A month later he began a new role as a hospitalist at Paris Community Hospital. Transitioning to a hospitalist allowed him to continue providing healthcare in the community and presented a new challenge. "I will forever remember the warmth that I always received from the people of Edgar County, from the beginning to now. This is home," Dr. Sutton said.

### The early days

Dr. Sutton was born in Madison, Wisc., and grew up in East Alton, Ill. He received his medical degree from the University of Illinois College of Medicine and completed his residency at Michael Reese Hospital in Chicago. Outside of work, he is known for his love of gardening, traveling, railroad photography, trains, and the St. Louis Cardinals.



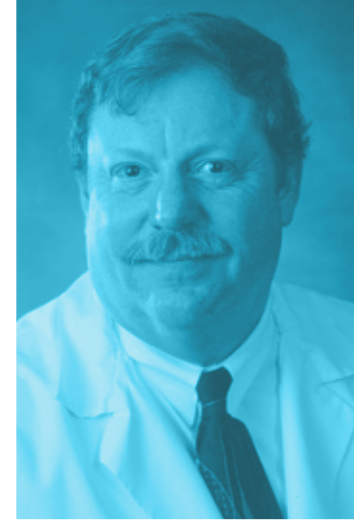
## Excellence Award

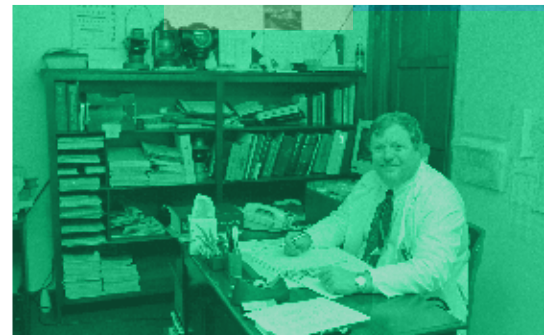


## Accomplishments ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★ ★

Dr. Sutton was instrumental in establishing Paris Community Hospital's critical care area, which originally was located in the inpatient unit. He introduced cardiac stress testing to Paris and developed the hospital's cardiac rehabilitation program. In the 1980s and 1990s, Dr. Sutton and Dr. Phipps fostered their relationship, sharing medical knowledge and after-hours call duty.

While at Horizon Health, Dr. Sutton served as chief of medical staff, as well as chief of medicine for several departments. He was an American Diabetes Association recognized provider and medical director for many area nursing homes. He provided health education in the community, addressing such topics as dementia and Alzheimer's disease. He regularly addressed Horizon Health's annual Caregivers Expo, spoke at the hospital's caregiver and cancer support group meetings, and presented to seniors at monthly "Dine with a Doc" programs.

Dr. Sutton continues to live in Paris with his wife, Carolyn, formerly a social worker at Horizon Health.

# EZ Care–Marshall

Marshall-area residents have shown consistent support to the idea of Horizon Health opening a medical clinic in their community. Horizon Health responded in 2019 with the EZ Care-Marshall walk-in clinic.

The clinic debuted February 1 in the former Wellum chiropractic building at 1602 N. Illinois Highway 1, opening three days a week on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Clinic hours were expanded to seven days a week seven months later (on September 1) to accommodate the growing demand for services. The expanded hours in Marshall mirror those at EZ Care in Paris, with both facilities providing seven-day-a-week coverage, 362 days a year.

Like EZ Care in Paris, EZ Care-Marshall treats minor, non-emergency health conditions and sees patients age three months and older on a first-come, first-served basis. Lab services are available in Marshall, with testing performed at the Paris Community Hospital laboratory.

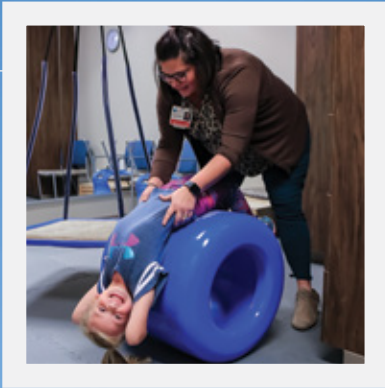
## Introducing EZ Care–Marshall

A public open house was held June 3, which included a ribbon cutting ceremony with the Marshall Area Chamber of Commerce. Attendees toured the building and met staff.

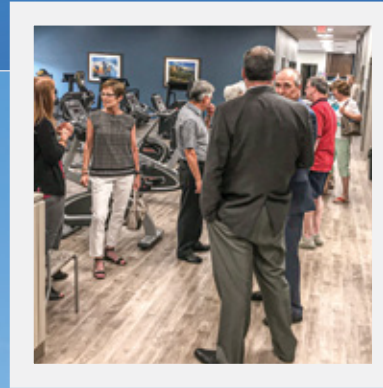

**Open House**—The public received a firsthand look at the new Rehabilitation Services building on May 28. Rehab and sleep services staff were available to answer questions.





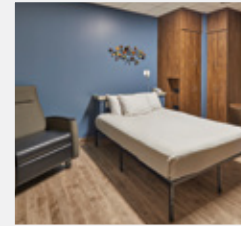

## State-of-the-art Rehabilitation Services

Located behind Paris Community Hospital, the 21,262 square-foot structure includes the latest therapy equipment, seven private treatment rooms, several semi-private rooms, aquatic therapy, and a dedicated pediatric rehab area. It also houses a sleep lab and provides an additional 3,848 square-foot space for an independently owned/operated dialysis center.

The facility opened on April 22, 2019 and is approximately three times larger than the former rehab area. The new building not only addresses the need for more physical space, but also allows the rehab department to expand its service offerings. This includes growing its sports medicine program, developing a pediatrics service line, and offering aquatic therapy.

# ...deserving *the Best.*

Paris Community Hospital, a service of Horizon Health, received national recognition when it was named a **TOP 100 CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL** in the country for its outstanding performance in several areas. The recognition came from The Chartis Center for Rural Health, a comprehensive advisory and analytics services firm that specializes in the healthcare industry.

PCH was one of only two critical access hospitals in Illinois to receive the award. Nationally, only 100 of the more than 1,300 critical access hospitals in the US received the top honor. "Critical access hospital" is a federal designation designed to improve access to healthcare by keeping essential services in rural communities. PCH is one of 53 critical access hospitals in Illinois.

Regarded as one of the industry's most significant designations of performance excellence, the



annual Top 100 Critical Access Hospital award is based upon the results of the Hospital Strength INDEX® from iVantage Health Analytics. The INDEX leverages 50 rural-relevant indicators across eight pillars of hospital strength (i.e., Inpatient Market Share, Outpatient Market Share, Cost, Charge, Quality, Outcomes, Patient Perspective, and Financial Stability) to determine an overall score for each hospital. Each of the INDEX's 50 indicators is culled from publicly-available data sources.

## ★★★★ "4-Star" Rating

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) awarded Horizon Health a "4-Star" rating for its acute inpatient satisfaction scores. The scores were derived from CMS's Hospital Consumer Assessment of Health Plans Survey (HCAHPS).

In addition to its 4-Star rating, Horizon Health was recognized as a top performer in all quality outcomes identified by the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy Medicare Beneficiary Quality Improvement Program (MBQIP).

These quality outcomes include Patient Safety/Inpatient, Patient Engagement, Care Transitions, and Outpatient Measures.

## New Patient Services Area

To help make the patient experience easier and more convenient, Horizon Health created a Patient Services area at Paris Community Hospital. Strategically located between the hospital and Paris Clinic, the area replaced the hospital registration desk, central scheduling, emergency waiting area, and gift shop.

This “one-stop shop” now offers:

- A Patient Services representative or “greeter” who is the first point of contact for patients
- A large registration area with private “bays” to schedule testing and obtain insurance authorization
- The ability to meet with a financial assistance representative
- The ability to request copies of medical records
- A bill payment center with cashier
- A patient bill estimator that provides real-time information on how much a patient will owe after insurance pays for a particular service

Patient Services streamlined a number of services to make one centralized location, staff, department, and leadership. Previously, 50 employees operated independently of each other in four separate departments: registration, health information, financial services, and central scheduling and referrals. The change helped improve efficiency, communication, and cross-training abilities.

To provide more space for Patient Services, the hospital gift shop was moved to a new 3,100-square-foot building addition near the outpatient lab. The space includes a café, inpatient pharmacy, and conference room.

Horizon Health received the Illinois Critical Access Hospital Network's 2019 IMPACT Award for creating its new Patient Services area. Patients no longer have to navigate different areas of the hospital to register, request medical records, or talk to a financial assistance coordinator.







# Preventative Health

The healthcare industry's shift to a preventative care model occurred close to home in 2019, with Horizon Health implementing numerous health and wellness initiatives. These included:

- Blood pressure screenings at area football and basketball games
- The installation of sunscreen stations at popular summertime attractions, including Tiger Falls Splash Park in Paris and the Marshall public pool
- Free water aerobics classes for seniors at the Marshall public pool
- A monthly “communicator campaign” utilizing athena (electronic health record software) to provide patient health education
- Expanded presence at health fairs – North American Lighting, GSI, and Elanco
- Sponsorship of the fifth annual *Back to School Bang* event
- Dermatology education and movement classes at the *Marshall Area Youth Network's School's Out* program
- Creation of a *Ladies Night Out* series



# 911 Contract Awarded

Horizon Health established an ambulance service in 2018, assisting the community with non-emergency calls, emergency calls, and patient transports. A year later, the Edgar County Board awarded Horizon Health the Special Services Area No. 1 Ambulance District (911) contract, effective June 1, 2019.

The county board determined Horizon Health's contract bid to be the lowest and most responsible, saving taxpayers nearly \$2 million over the contract's duration. When the contract became effective June 1, Horizon Health had three ambulances and was pursuing a fourth. It also had an emergency response vehicle available.

While vehicles and equipment were deemed important, Horizon Health believes people are its greatest asset. EMS staff average 12 years or more of public safety experience. Combined they have more than 250 years of experience and consist of flight paramedics/flight nurses, firefighter/paramedics, and pre-hospital RNs.

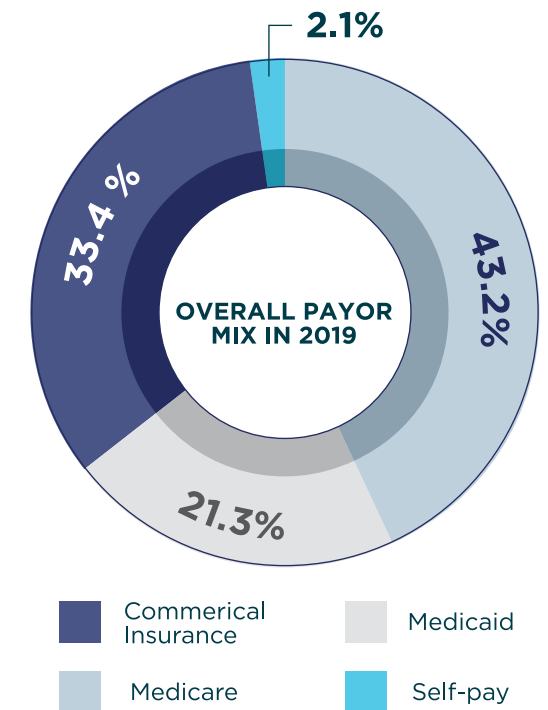

## 2019 YEAR-END SUSTAINING MEMBERS

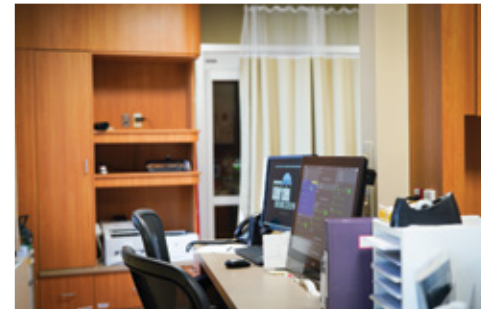
